Newcomers to our parish please call the parish office at your earliest convenience to be registered.

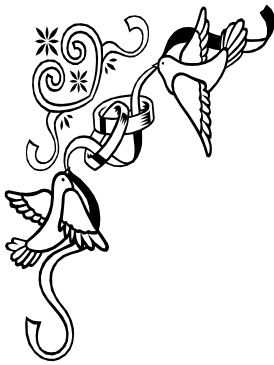
Matrimony: Couples should call 6 months in advance for required preparation.

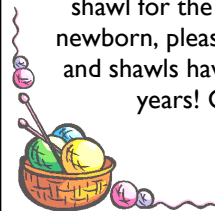
Campus Ministry
