### Marriage Prep

Couples often ask about the “6 month” preparation before they are married in the Catholic Church.

The actual preparation period for marriage is not 6 months. The reason there is a 6 month notice is for the parish to announce the upcoming wedding by way of a “banns” in the bulletin. A “bann” is an announcement.

The marriage preparation period can be either longer or shorter than six months. A few things to consider if you are thinking of marrying in the Catholic Church:

- Make sure you have a minister secured before you settle on a date and place
- Marrying a non-Catholic is not an impediment to marry. Your non-Catholic fiancée will participate with you in preparation for the wedding.
- If there is a divorce in either or both parties past, then make sure you have spoken to your parish priest before the engagement.
- Planning your wedding should include consulting your parish to find out what is allowable in your ceremony.

Please be respectful also of our handicapped and elderly.
