New Memorial Celebration Tomorrow
Pope Francis has decreed that "the Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church," should be inscribed in the Roman Calendar on the Monday after Pentecost and be celebrated every year in churches throughout the world. A "memorial" is a lower-ranked feast day. Celebrations of feast days in the Roman Rite of the Catholic Church are distinguished according to their importance and named either as solemnities, feasts or memorials. It traced the history of this veneration down the centuries from the period of the early church. St. Augustine said "Mary is the mother of the members of Christ, because with charity she cooperated in the rebirth of the faithful into the Church".
