Who is RCIA for?

Fundamentally, the RCIA is for those adults who are unbaptized and are seeking to become a fully initiated Christian.

The RCIA is also for those who are Christian or raised in a Christian tradition but want to join the Catholic Faith.

We also are open to those who are Baptized Catholics who are wanting to become fully initiated through Communion and Confirmation.

Parking Courtesy: It is VITAL that parishioners use good judgement and courtesy in the use of the parking lot. It is a limited area and there is nothing at this time we can do about it. This makes it impossible for service trucks to pass through the lot as well as impeding the construction machinery and vehicles. This also provides a danger in case of emergency vehicles such as paramedics or firetrucks cannot get into the lot to attend to a crisis or need. Please utilize the parking spaces as marked out and park in places that are not blocking other vehicles nor in areas that are narrow. Also parking at the entrance (University Dr) or at the very end (5th St.) are dangerous and can be a risk to pedestrians and other drivers. Please be respectful also of our handicapped and elderly.

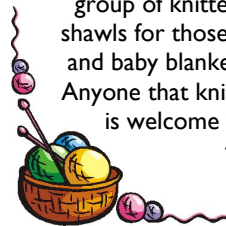
